## **SUMMARY<sup>1</sup>**

This complementary study under the *Nunavik Comparative Price Index 2006* compares the prices of 148 food products, 17 household products, 15 personal care products, 14 models of snowmobile, regular unleaded gasoline and certain hunting and fishing equipment in Nunavik and the Quebec City area with prices in three other regions of Québec: the Magdalen Islands, the James Bay area and the Lower North Shore.

The data collected under the *Nunavik Comparative Price Index 2006* were compared with prices gathered in Cap-aux-Meules, Matagami and La Romaine. The data collected are based on national socio-economic indicators as well as the goods, products and services list used by Statistics Canada to produce *The Consumer Price Index*. This method makes it possible to measure differences in prices of items sold in Nunavik, the Quebec City area and the three other regions contemplated under the complementary study.

The results of the complementary study demonstrate that all the products compared are, on average and to varying degrees, more expensive in Nunavik than in the other regions contemplated under the study.

## INTRODUCTION

This report is an abridged version of the report study entitled *Indices comparatifs des prix du Nunavik 2006 — Complément d'étude — Îles-de-la-Madeleine, Nord-du-Québec, Basse-Côte-Nord*, originally published in French, and which describes the methodological aspects.

## 1.0 RÉSULTS


### 1.1 Food

The complementary study is based on the interregional comparison of 148 food products that were available in the three regions contemplated under the complementary agreement. Designating the Quebec City area as the reference region (index 100), the complementary study shows that a food basket which costs \$100 in the Quebec City area, is \$160 in Nunavik, \$109 on the Magdalen Islands, \$106 in the James Bay area and \$119 along the Lower North Shore. (Figure 1, Table 1).

As was the case under the NCPI 2006, these results should be interpreted carefully for two reasons. First, they are based on the assumption that the same products are typically purchased by households in the five regions contemplated under the study; this assumption has not yet been verified.

Secondly, the results were obtained without the application of weighting, which is to say without taking into consideration the importance of each product in different households; the relative importance of products has also not yet been verified.

The comparative analysis of prices demonstrates that the vast majority of food products are more expensive in Nunavik than in the other regions contemplated under the complementary study.

## 1.2 Hunting and Fishing Activities

Snowmobiles are one of the most important pieces of equipment used by residents in Nunavik as well as in La Romaine, where this means of transportation is used for a good part of each year.

The comparative price index is based on the average price of 14 models sold by four different manufacturers. The index is 116 for Nunavik (index for Kuujjuaq), 103 for the Lower North Shore and 100 for the James Bay area (shipping and pre-delivery inspection included, taxes not included) (Figure 3 and Table 2).

Snowmobile operation costs are also higher in Nunavik due to the price of gasoline which between September 1, 2005 and August 31, 2006 sold for \$1.44 per litre in Nunavik compared with \$1.20 along the Lower North Shore, \$1.01 on the Magdalen Islands, 97.0¢ in the James Bay area and 97.8¢ in the Quebec City area. The comparative price index for gasoline is respectively 147, 123, 103 and 100.

Moreover, it may be noted that in Nunavik in September 2006, following the most recent delivery of gasoline, prices for the next 12 months were set at \$1.69 per litre in the villages serviced by Shell Canada and \$1.57 per litre in the villages serviced by the Federation of Cooperatives of the James Bay area (average price, \$1.60). This new average price represents an increase of 11% compared with last year, even while the price of gasoline is dropping in the Quebec City area. Between September 13 and October 3, 2006, weekly data collected in the three regions contemplated under the complementary study demonstrate that the average price of gasoline is 95.7¢ on the Magdalen Islands, 90.6¢ in the James Bay area,

\$1.12 along the Lower North Shore and 89.4¢ in the Quebec City area (Figure 5, Table 3a).


A few further products were also systematically compared under the complementary study. These products included propane and camping fuel, flashlights and a few calibres of ammunition (Table 4). As well, the range of firearms used and available in the three regions contemplated under the complementary study would have required the collection of new data in Nunavik and the Quebec City area

## 1.3 Household products and personal care products

The study demonstrates that in comparison with the Quebec City area household products are, on average, 79% more expensive in Nunavik, 5% more expensive on the Magdalen Islands, 7% more expensive in Matagami and 34% more expensive in La Romaine (Table 5).



As for personal care products, the index for each region is 141 for Nunavik, 110 for the Magdalen Islands, 108 for the James Bay area and 133 for the Lower North Shore (Table 6).

## CONCLUSION

The comparisons carried out under the complementary study demonstrate that, on average, the products examined are more expensive in Nunavik. Furthermore, in the case of taxable goods, Nunavik residents pay an increased share of tax as it applicable to a higher retail price.

Similar to observations made under the NCPI 2006, one of the greatest disadvantages faced by Nunavimmiut is the absence of a genuine consumer market like that found in the Quebec City area, as well as on the Magdalen Islands, in the James Bay area and along the Lower North Shore. Discussions held with key informants in the three regions contemplated under the complementary study suggest that the residents of these regions are able to increase their consumer options by "going down" to Amos or Rouyn; or via continual, well-established maritime and air links with the continent; or via snowmobile trails to Route 138 and Québec's road network.

The results of this complementary comparative price index for Nunavik will hopefully contribute to the development of corrective public policies. Although the parameters of the complementary study did not make it possible to identify the reasons for these regional differences, shipping costs could be seen as an important part of the problem. In this respect, a study of the impacts of transportation costs on products consumed in these regions could clarify this situation, and would permit public policies developed from the conclusions presented herein to be based on comprehensive information.
