Only $2 \%$ of full-time jobs pay less than $\$ 20,000$ per year in 2005 and one quarter pays between $\$ 20,000$ and $\$ 29,999$ annually. Another $38 \%$ provide annual salaries between $\$ 30,000$ and $\$ 39,999$, while $20 \%$ give between $\$ 40,000$ and $\$ 49,999$ and $15 \%, \$ 50,000$ or more.
